While the barn has been a bit cold this meet, the fact that leading jockey Luis Saez picks up the mount is notable, and this filly seems to tower over the competition that she faces today. She'll also get a slight turn back in distance to the $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile.

LONGSHOT: Race 9 - #10 End Play

Coming off of a well beaten effort, I think this horse will fly under the radar and be a good price for a top barn and a top jock. Javier Castellano picks up the mount for trainer Tom Bush, and faced the likes of Bricks and Mortar last time out. Prior to that, he was very consistent at a variety of distances. He gets a drop in class today and will make his second local start this meet.
